## Riverdown Park, Salisbury Your local amenities.

Riverdown Park is in a semi-rural location close to Hampton Park and Bishopdown, Salisbury. The development enjoys green and far-reaching stunning landscape grounds with adjoining cycle ways and footpaths leading to open spaces.

Riverdown Park's ideal location provides excellent transport links to destinations in the South West and East of England, the City is well serviced by the A30 leading North to the A303/M4 and South to the M27/M3 motorways. The main train station is 4 Km from the centre and is 88 minutes by rail to London Waterloo.

Salisbury Cathedral, which was established in 1220, is renowned for its Gothic Cathedral and tall Spire, also boasts its large mechanical clock which was installed in 1386. The Cathedral contains one of only four surviving copies of the Magna Carta. Other areas of interest nearby are, The Roman Fort

of Old Sarum, Hudson Fields, and Wiltshire's most famous historical landmark Stonehenge. Stonehenge is part of a World Heritage Site as being of outstanding international importance and therefore as deserving special protection. This is nominated to/designated by the World Heritage Convention, (an organization of UNESCO).

Wiltshire is renowned for its stunning countryside. The county contains three areas of outstanding natural beauty; Cranborne Chase and the West Wiltshire Downs in the South West, and the North Wessex Downs in the East. Salisbury Plain is another popular visitor area. In addition to being a military training area, the plain contains many delightful walks and is home to plenty of unique wildlife including the Great Bustard – the County's bird.

The area has a good selection of amenities including a community centre, convenience



stores, health and fitness club and recreation ground whilst Salisbury is a delight for shopping, with three city centre malls filled with high street favourites. The Wilton Shopping Mall just three miles out of the city offers outlet shopping at very competitive prices. Also on offer in the city centre is a wide range of independent boutiques, arts and crafts shops and specialist food outlets which cluster around Fisherton Street, Winchester Street and High Street, with Gastronomic delights, you'll be spoilt for choice from an array of stylish coffee shops, traditional pubs, bars, restaurants and night clubs. Salisbury hosts an annual Food and Drink Festival in September.

The Salisbury Playhouse is one of the UK's leading producing theatres, with a wide range of classic and contemporary plays, musicals, children's theatre and pantomime presented throughout the year and the

annual Ageas Salisbury International Arts Festival is held during May and June.

Salisbury's excellent leisure facilities include the Downton Leisure Centre and Parkwood Health and Fitness which boasts modern gyms, swimming pools and exercise studios. The South Wilts Golf Club offers a 27 hole golf course.

The City offers a superb selection of schools making it a popular choice for families. Greentrees Primary School has a good reputation and is just 10 minutes walk from Riverdown Park. Nearby South Wiltshire Grammar School for Girls and Bishopdown Wordsworth School are among the top 100 state secondary schools in the country. Finally, there is only a short walk to the local bus stop, medical centre, vets and convenience shop too.
